Faculty of Chemistry – Entrance Exam Rules (Candidate for Chemistry Program – First cycle study)

- 1. The exam is obligatory for Candidates on the first-cycle Chemistry program who have completed the first step of the application process and had their required admission documents verified positively by Admission to English-language studies Faculty Coordinator and Field of Study Coordinator.
- 2. Candidates whose educational documents were issued outside the EU, OECD or EFTA, or whose qualifications are not automatically recognised or covered by a bilateral agreement, must pass the entrance exam.
- 3. Information about possible registration dates and times for the entrance exam will be available to candidates on their personal accounts in the IRC admission system after logging in.
- 4. Confirmation of the specific date from the available slots will be provided within 48 hours. If confirmation is not received within this timeframe, the candidate should contact the Admission Coordinator of Faculty of Chemistry by email at **study.chem@uwr.edu.pl**.
- 5. Candidates are required to prepare for the exam using the provided topics.
- 6. The Faculty of Chemistry examination committee will conduct the exam online via the MS Teams platform.
- 7. The maximum number of points that can be obtained in the exam is 20. However, the candidate must obtain at least 10 points for the exam to be considered passed.
- 8. The exam will last a maximum of 30 minutes.
